AMG Arts – Ann Gorman textile and paper artist using vivid colours and intense detail.

Bee Free Kids Clothing – Caoimhe Tuthill, range of children's clothing and accessories designed with imagination in mind.

Colette Gough Ink Drawings – Freehand ink drawings on canvas using celtic designs.
